

# Index

**Note:** In the text of this book, people's identifications and their form of name were taken from the original sources, without any attempt at reconciling any inconsistencies or other oddities (such as the use of the husband's initials or forename in the name of a married woman). Wherever possible, as an aid to genealogists, these inconsistencies have been removed in this index, and forenames have been added to incomplete names (such as 'Mrs Hill'). Consequently, there may be minor differences between an index entry and the form of name which appears in the text of the book. References to photographs or other illustrations are in **bold**. There is often text about the photograph on the same page. Group photographs have also been indexed (where people are identified in captions).
